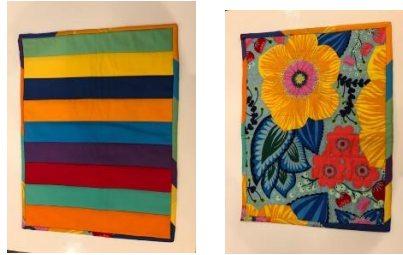


Placemats Sewing Instructions Canyon Quilters of San Diego

Thank You for joining the Guild's efforts to create placemats for our philanthropy efforts!

The following items are in your kit: Nine 2 ½" X 14" strips 14" X 19" Batting
14" X 19" Backing Fabric Binding

Tools you will need: Sewing Machine, Thread, Bobbin Thread should match or contrast the placemat's backing fabric, Iron and Pressing Mat or Ironing Board

Sewing Instructions: Use ¼" seam allowances.

Step 1: Lay the Backing Fabric wrong side up - Press

Step 2: Lay the Batting on top of the Backing.

Step 3: Choose the best design order of the strip prints. **Figure 1**

Lay the first strip (right side up) across the 14" width and stitch across the top end of the placemat to hold the strip in place. **Figure 2**

Step 4: Lay the second strip on top of the first one (right sides together) stitch. **Figure 3**

Step 5: Press the strip down.

Step 6: Repeat Steps 4 and 5 to the end of the placemat. **Figure 4**

Step 7: Attach binding, your choice of technique. Use either complete machine stitching or machine stitching on the front and hand stitching on the back.
